This funding will be used to

Improve Learning Outcomes, particularly to support those most in need:

- Increase experiential learning for 'at risk Indigenous senior students' who attend school within the metropolitan area.
- Increase the attendance of students in the Deadly Science Course.
- Maintain the high rate of course completion of the Deadly Science Program.

Our initiatives include

1. Building teacher professional learning on differentiation for low achieving, high achieving and EALD students.
2. Providing the opportunity for Indigenous students within the metropolitan area to engage in a cultural camp on Stradbroke Island for four days.
3. Creating the opportunity for positive relationships with students to develop outside the conventional school setting.
4. Allowing fortnightly discussion cycles for planning, teaching, assessment, moderation and zone of proximal development.
